Malvira winery began its production in the 1950's under the guidance of Giuseppe Damonte. Today the estate is run by Massimo and Roberto Damonte, Giuseppe's sons, together with their sons Francesco, Pietro and Giacomo, who inherited his passion for wine making. Despite constant growth in production and exposure to new markets, the winery is still a family business.
