The blend includes grapes like Grüner Veltliner, Sauvignon Blanc, Riesling, and Chardonnay, which are harvested on the same day to create a balanced profile with natural acidity and complexity.

THE STORY

Ambrositsch farms a total of four hectares —three on the right side of the Danube and one hectare on the left bank— in ten different parcels. Each vineyard is unique, with a distinctive terroir and microclimate. Jutta farms each organically, but does not have certification. Ambrositsch says that the biggest threat to the vineyards is hail and white boars that live in the surrounding forests and using conventional products will not help against either!
