THE STORY

La Clé de la Femme Brut and Rosé Champagne are small production wines from highly-acclaimed vineyards in Champagne, France.

The Champagne comes from the Aube Valley, an area just southwest of the heart of Champagne. Here the climate is slightly warmer, featuring clay and limestone soils. Vineyards are scattered on rolling hills of forests, farms and streams and the region is dominated by grower-producers looking to make unique wines with distinct character.
