THE FACTS



COUNTRY: Spain

REGION: Castilla y Leon

APPELLATION: Bierzo

CEPAGE: 100% Mencia

WINEMAKING: 100% Mencía. Vines planted since 1963. Tended in river stone and clay soil at 525 m (1,722 ft) elevation. The free-run juice is drained at low temperature without previous maceration and under an inert atmosphere. Alcoholic fermentation in stainless steel tanks for 12 days at 12C. 100% unoaked. Some of the carbonation is kept in the wine during fermentation to exhibit some fizz at the time of drinking.

ALCOHOL BY VOLUME: 12.5%

THE STORY

Vinos Atlántico was founded with the purpose of preserving the winemaking heritage of Alberto Orte's family.

Independently producing wine throughout Spain since the late 1800s. Alberto produces two types of wines: wines of unique terroirs, which are labeled as Alberto Orte, and wines from village- designated vineyards that are more approachable, which are labeled as Vinos Atlántico.

PHILOSOPHY: Alberto believes that low yields, balanced soils, and top-quality raw materials are three fundamental factors to creating terroir-reflective and balanced wines.
