The vineyard parcels selected by Terroirs Vivants are judged by the potential of the fruit's expressiveness. They are worked, from planting to vinification, with the aim of giving you living "vivant" wines that are naturally "sympathique," or friendly. In other words, adapted to your desire for pleasurable wines at accessible prices. La Marouette wines are grown in the Languedoc region of southern France.
