Bosman is a wine of social impact. Founded in the 18th Century in South Africa, the winery is in its 8-generation, 26%-Black-owned, with a team of three women winemakers.

OVERALL: Low-acid, fruit-forward, chillable red

AROMAS / FLAVORS: Delicate violet, raspberry and red plum. Some notes of scrub, almost hoppy.

MOUTHFEEL: Lean
