THE FACTS

COUNTRY: France

WINEMAKING: The grapes are not destemmed, the cuvaïson lasts for three weeks and the élevage encompasses an additional 18 months in traditional foudre wood vats before the wine is bottled unfiltered.

THE STORY

The Bois de Boursan, founded in 1955 by Jean Versino (Jean-Paul's father), is a ten-hectare domaine with the entirety of its vineyards situated within the confines of the village of Chateauneuf-du-Pape. Gilles Gasq is the proprietor of the Domaine La Manarine, situated on the Plan de Dieu in Travaillan.
