COUNTRY: USA - CA

APPELLATION: Paso Robles

CEPAGE: 79% Zinfandel, 17% Petite Sirah, 4% Grenache

WINEMAKING: Most of the individual lots that came to be 2020 Westside were gently destemmed and fermented in tanks and small lots prior to being pressed. The resulting free-run wines were aged separately in roughly 30% new American, French and Hungarian oak barrels and puncheons.
