His winemaking began in the late 80s, and for 25 vintages the Davis Family label churns out stellar Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Zinfandel, and increasingly a broader range of wines from Mendocino to Monterey County. Multiple vineyard sources allow for wine variety via micro-climates.

They were farming sustainably & organically decades ago, and consistent organic-sustainable practices in farming and winemaking (native yeast, no fining, filtration) remain a central philosophy.

The whole family is passionate in their pursuit and believe wine is an essential element in a rich and wonderful life—adding a delicious layer to both meals and to friendships.
