To taste Joaquin is not only to experience a stunning bottle of Fiano or Aglianico, but to undergo a paradigm shift—to sense things heretofore unencountered in these varieties and these terroirs. Raffaele Pagano's family thinks he's crazy. This fourth-generation heir apparent to his Salerno-based clan's income stream—two million bottles per year spread among three wineries—chose a wildly different path, and today Raffaele produces a mere 18,000 bottles annually, from three and a half hectares in Irpinia and Capri. But they're his wines, made according to his vision, and this Campanian maverick wouldn't have it any other way.
