This wine defines the unique characteristics of our neighborhood through a confluence of clones, climate, and soil from this renowned region. A classic example of Pinot Noir in its purity, elegance, nuance, and exquisite balance. Barrel aged in 20% new French Oak for 11 months.

THE STORY

Craft winemaking begins with sourcing excellent quality grapes with the goal of creating an authentic and expressive wine. Hand harvesting, native yeast fermentation, minimal intervention, gentle punch-downs, quality barrels for aging and gravity to move delicate wines help accomplish this goal.

Winemaker Rick Moshin has been producing natural, terroir-driven wines in the Russian River Valley since 1989. He sustainably farms his vineyards and with the help of a dedicated winemaking team, gently makes small-lot, premium wines in his gravity-flow winery in Sonoma.
