WINEMAKING: Each block of each vineyard was harvested and fermented separately. 15-20% whole cluster. Native yeast fermentation in open-top fermenters. Punch downs by hand three times a day during peak fermentation. Average 21 days on the skins. Bottled unfiltered and unfined.

AGING: 10 months in French oak (32% new)

ANNUAL PRODUCTION: 2223 cases
