

Bosman Family Vineyards Generation 8 Cabernet Sauvignon

THE FACTS



COUNTRY: South Africa

REGION: Western Cape

APPELLATION: Wellington

CEPAGE: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

WINEMAKING: Grapes are hand harvested and destemmed before the onset of fermentation. Pump-overs are utilized for color extraction. Before alcoholic fermentation is complete, it is pressed to make sure that the tannin expression is fine and subtle. A portion of the wine is matured in new French oak for 6 months to create a complex wine with supple supple tannins.

THE STORY

Bosman is a wine of social impact. Founded in the 18th Century in South Africa, the winery is in its 8-generation, 26%-Black-owned, with a team of three women winemakers.
